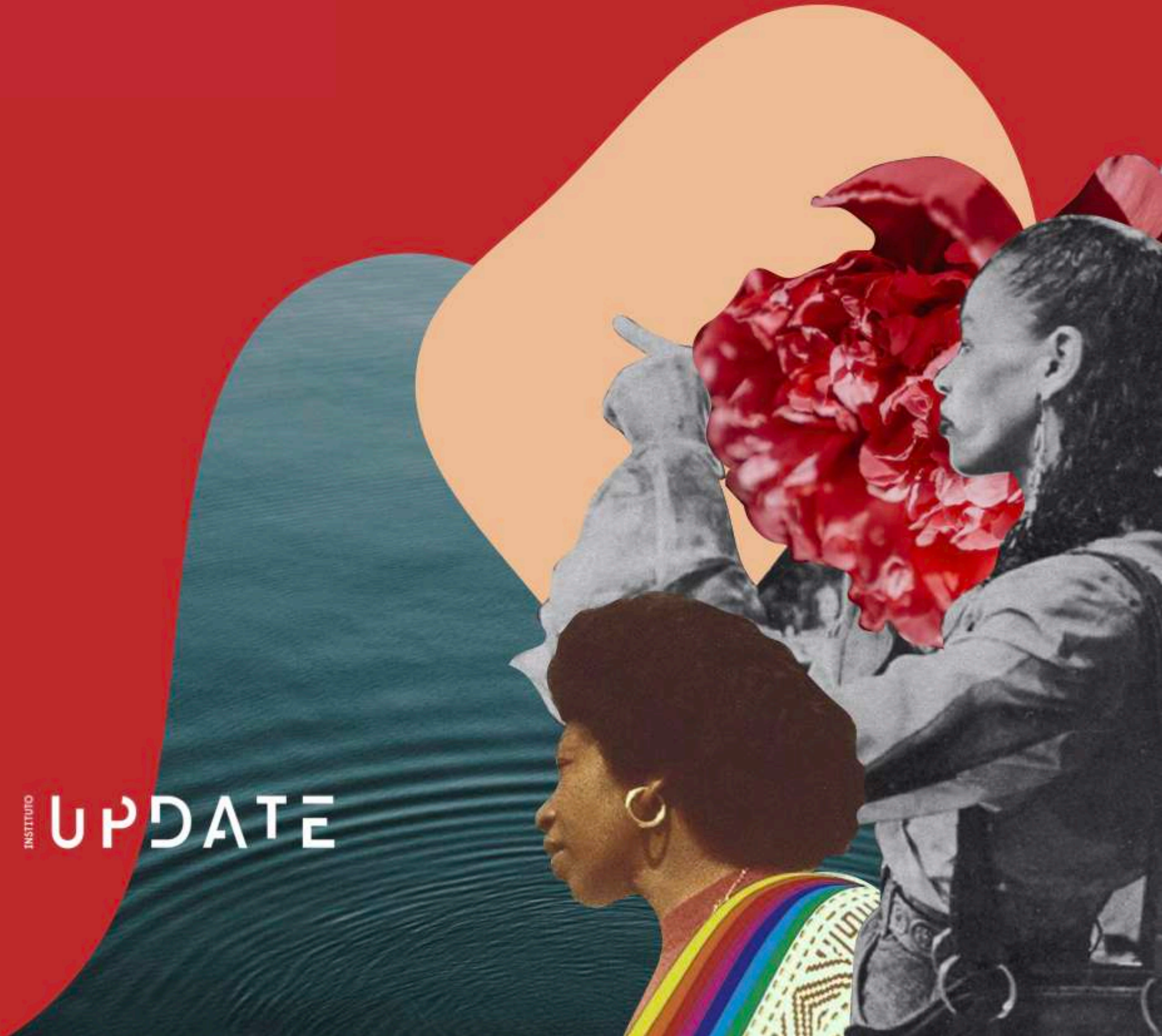

With legislatures becoming more egalitarian and diverse, which is now an irreversible fact, young female leaders in Latin America are become political protagonists. It won't be long before more women occupy this space.

Currently, Latin America is the leading region in the world in the number of women holding local and legislative office. It also faces a growing climate of intimidations and violence against women in politics.

**It is estimated that six out of every ten female politicians has suffered political harassment in Bolivia, a country that has the second most egalitarian parliament in the world.*

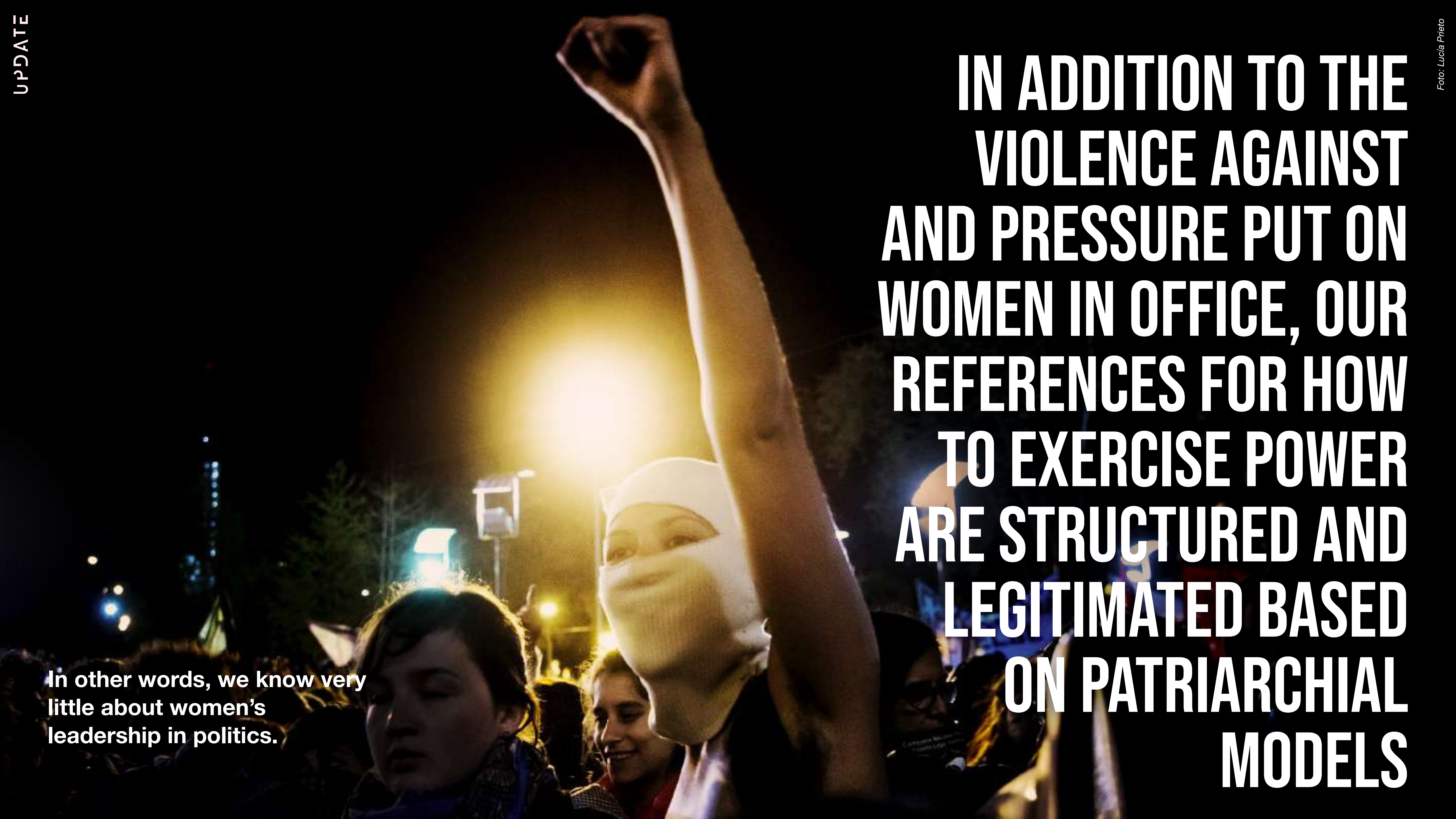

We must work together to create other models for doing politics based on the experiences of women and increase diversity in spaces of power, including more black and indigenous women.

In other words, we know very little about women's leadership in politics.

ABOUT WHOM


Women who have won elected office (legislative and executive), are from different political persuasions and territories, mirror the ethno-racial diversity of the region and are aligned with the idea that the vision, lived experience and bodies of women can transform politics and society.

Argentina, Brazil, Bolivia, Chile, Colombia e Mexico

FOR WHOM

Chiefly for women who are engaged in institutional politics or who will take this step soon. Additionally, for the political innovation ecosystem itself and for strengthening democracy. And finally, for civil society and thought leaders.

EMERGING POLITICS WOMEN

OBJECTIVE

Accelerate the process of women, specifically black women, moving into political office. Support their resilience in the face of political violence by creating new references, strengthening support networks and contributing to political and technical development.

REVEAL women who are innovating in politics, their histories, political practices, challenges and potential;

SPREAD practices of these women leaders so that they can be recognized as agents of political change;

CONNECT Latin American female leaders in order to share knowledge, best practices and to construct a network of support in the region;

FOMENT the political and technical development of women of different ages, races, sexual orientations and origins (urban and rural, center and periphery) who are ready and willing to run for office

What is women-led political thinking and action?

What changes when women in politics meet and exchange?

_ Four 3-4 day immersions with spaces for reflection on and practice of women's leadership. Immersions with psychosocial care and reflection and articulation among Latin American women who are leading these processes in their countries in order to stimulate the creation of a support network for women moving into spaces of institutionalized power.

_ Promote secure exchange with among women who blazed a trail in politics with space to share their views on care, security, harassment, reception and community

PHASE IV - FOMENT
2020 ELECTIONS

How can we elect more women in a democratic and egalitarian way?

_Beyond creating knowledge and making it visible, it is important to impact reality. The content we create should contribute to increasing the chances that women will be elected.

_ We will adapt the content of the Democracy Training School and the LIANE platform (an Instituto Update project) to support the campaigns of women running for executive and legislative seats in the Brazilian municipal elections of 2020.

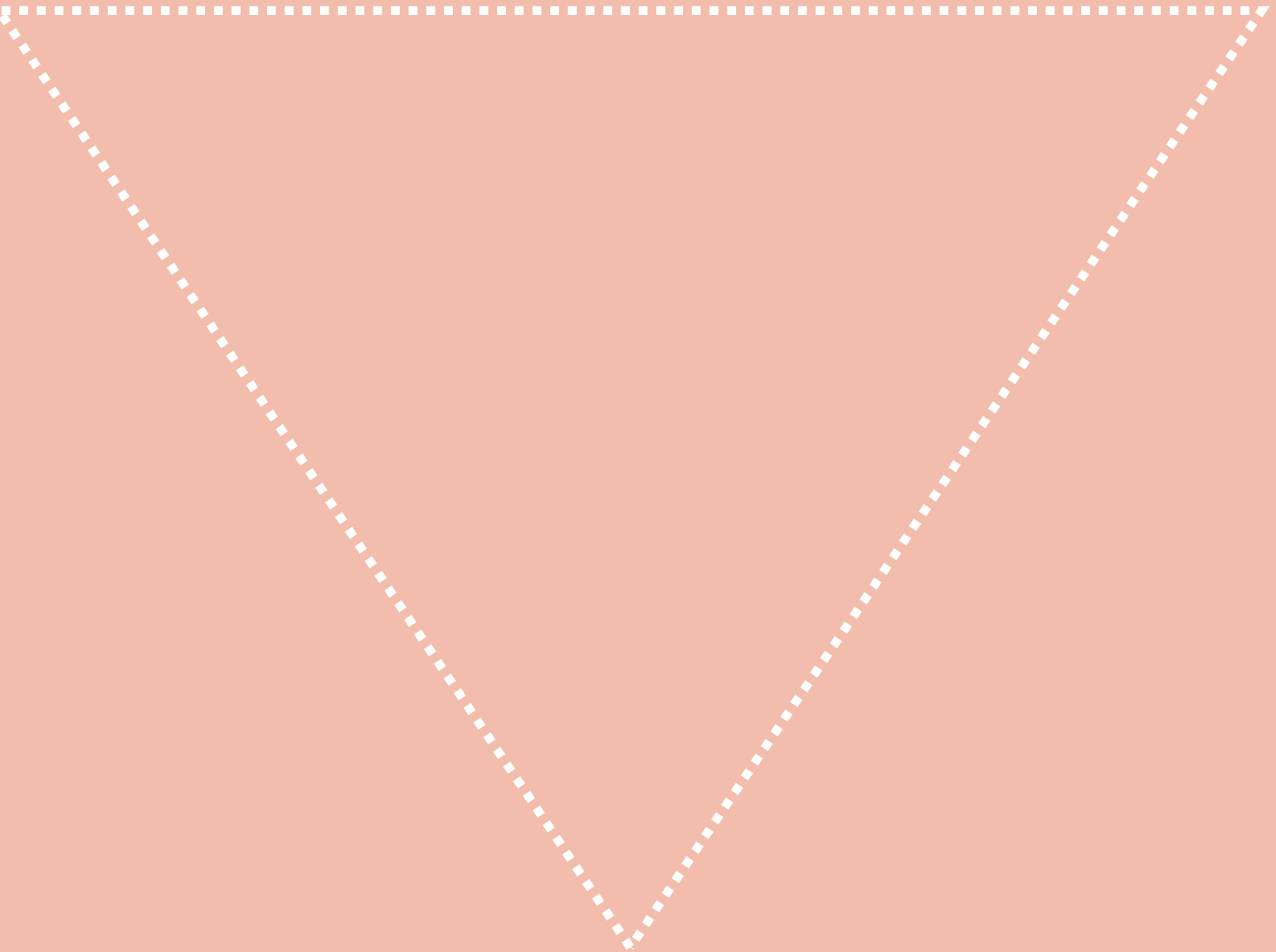

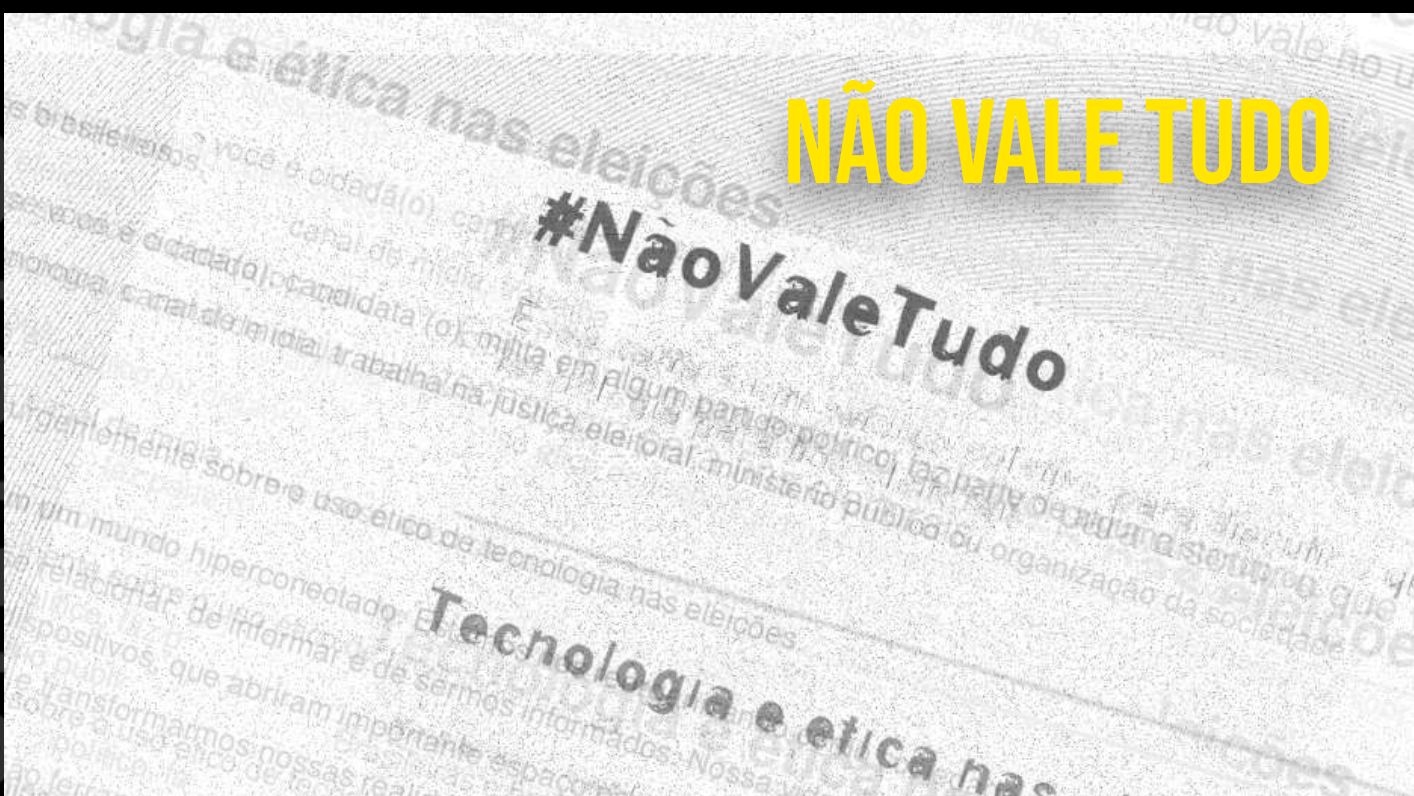

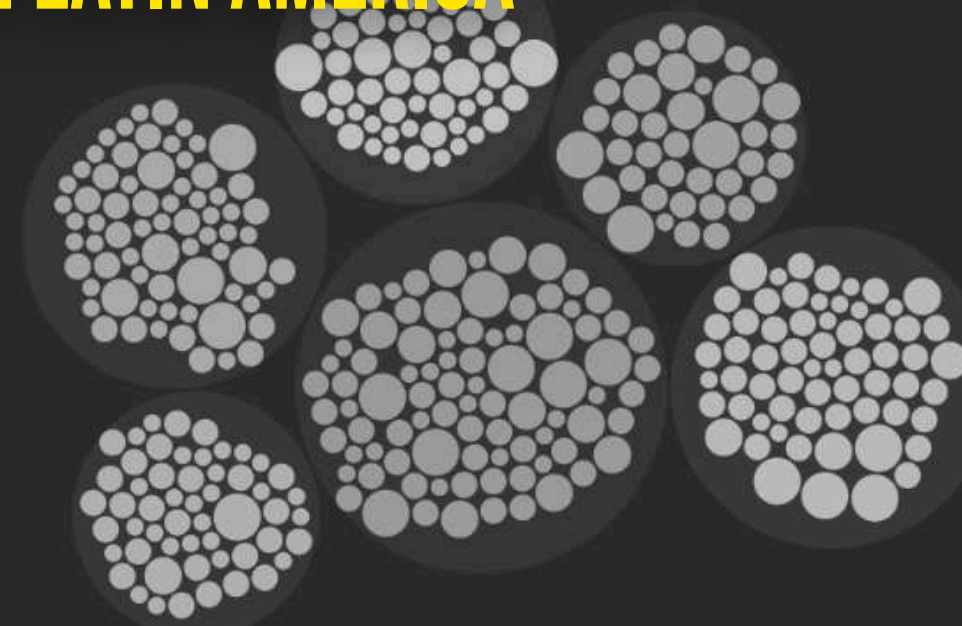

O Brasil que não se vê

Muito oportuna neste ano eleitoral a série "Política: modo de fazer" que a GloboNews inicia hoje em parceria com a Maria Fariña Filmes e o Instituto Update, revelando novas práticas

surgidas em comunidades e periferias. São dezenas de projetos criativos e transformadores em regiões metropolitanas como Belo Horizonte, Brasília, Recife, Rio de Janeiro e São Paulo, abordados em quatro capítulos, com direção da cineasta Yasmin Thayná e da colunista cultural Cristina Aragão, supervisora de programas da emissora. O projeto atual é uma continuidade de "Política: modo de usar", exibido no ano passado e ambos tendo como ponto de partida a pesquisa "Emergência política nas periferias", do Instituto Update, que mapeou 100 ações que, segundo as diretoras, o Brasil não costuma perceber. "É uma série muito desafiadora", diz Yasmin, "porque traz novo conceito e permite olhar a política feita no cotidiano, quando cada um resolve movimentar seu bairro, seu aglomerado, sua quebrada, sua favela". Para Cristina, o

mais impressionante foi a atitude dos entrevistados: "todos os que tiveram acesso à educação formal, a universidades — seja por cotas, seja por bolsas — estão devolvendo seus saberes para suas comunidades". Jéssica Cerqueira, uma das pesquisadoras, vai mais longe: "se o estado ou as instituições olhassem para as soluções propostas, as políticas públicas teriam muito mais impacto e seriam mais efetivas". O episódio de estreia hoje aborda as iniciativas "Data-labe", do laboratório de dados e narrativas do Complexo da Maré, no Rio; e "Jovem expressão", criada em Ceilândia, no Distrito Federal, a partir de um le-

vantamento sobre como a violência afeta a juventude. Nascida em Nova Iguaçu, filha de uma empregada doméstica e de um portelero de prédio, Yasmin é diretora e fundadora da Afrofix, uma plataforma que reúne produções assinadas por pessoas negras. São dela "Kbela, o filme", uma experiência sobre ser mulher e assumir a cor, libertando-se, por exemplo, dos padrões de beleza "caucasianos"; "Batalhas", um curta-metragem sobre a primeira vez que o pas-sinho eo funk subiram ao palco do Teatro Municipal do Rio, apresentados por ela em 2015, e a websérie "Afrotranscendência", que exalta os valores da negritude. Como diz Cristina, "quando as periferias se movimentam, o Brasil se movimenta junto". Ou pelo menos passa a prestar atenção.

Cineasta busca ação política fora dos partidos

Em nova série da GloboNews, Yasmin Thayná viaja por cinco estados para conhecer novas práticas nas comunidades

SÃO PAULO "O que você veio fazer aqui?", perguntavam à jovem cineasta Yasmin Thayná durante suas viagens por cinco estados brasileiros para produzir a série Política: Modo de Fazer, que estreia neste sábado (17), na GloboNews. Em primeiro trabalho para a televisão, ela explicava às pessoas que queria descobrir as novas práticas políticas da sociedade civil fora do contexto dos partidos tradicionais. "Ah, você deve estar sendo muito difícil, né? Porque aqui não tem nada sendo feito, só roubalheira..." Polí Yasmin não desistia. Ao contrário, encontrou dezenas de movimentos de participação popular, formados em sua maioria por grupos de jovens nas periferias de São Paulo, Recife, Brasília, Belo Horizonte e Rio de Janeiro. Yasmin conhece bem este mundo desde pequena e é ela própria um personagem emblemático deste país em transformação. Filha do pedreiro Osmar Machado, hoje portelero de prédio, e da doméstica Clauda, ela foi criada pela avó Zilda numa casa com quintal no bairro rural de Santa Rita, a 42 quilômetros de Nova Iguaçu, na Baixada Fluminense. Aos 25 anos, Yasmin está concluindo o curso de comunicação social com especialização em cinema na PUC-Rio. "Acho esse meio muito desafiador porque nos permite olhar para a política que é feita nos territórios, ou seja, a vida

um poder de branco. Para ser negra e querer dividir o mesmo espaço com quem nunca quis que pessoas como eu tivessem a possibilidade de fazer isso você tem de se fortalecer. E o cinema foi esse trabalho que trouxe tudo junto." Agora, Yasmin reencontrou a sua própria história de vida ao trabalhar na série, em parceria com Cristina Aragão. No programa, ela vai responder a perguntas que ela mesma se fez ao iniciar a jornada: por que uma roda de terapia comunitária, frequentada e organizada por jovens, no meio de uma praça na Ceilândia, no Distrito Federal, pode ser considerada como uma prática política? Ou ainda, por que um laboratório de análises de dados e geração cidadã no meio do Complexo da Maré é uma iniciativa política? Coprodução da Maria Fariña Filmes, Instituto Update e GloboNews, Política: Modo de Fazer é uma série de cinema e televisão — duas paixões de Yasmin — para mostrar um Brasil que a gente não costuma ver. Parece ficção, mas é tudo verdade nesta história, que tem um final feliz, contado por ela mesma, ao falar dos pais. "Eles gostam dos meus filmes, meu pai é superorgulhoso. As vezes, fico com ele na portaria do prédio onde trabalho. Para quase todos os moradores que passam, ele diz: 'Essa daqui é minha filha. Ela faz filmes'."
